Thank you for purchasing literature table space at the 2010 Labor Notes Conference. Our conference attracts a wide range of activists and educators, and will provide you with a good opportunity to promote your organization.

Literature tables cost \$250 for a full table for publishers, national unions, and educational institutions; \$150 for local unions, grassroots labor groups, and nonprofit media and specialty goods organizations. Half tables are available for small non-profits, striking or locked out workers, and good, but under-funded causes at \$75. Please fill out the form below.

Policies

For the most part, working a literature table at the Labor Notes Conference is self-explanatory, but there are a couple of guidelines that we require all vendors to follow:

1. Literature and merchandise sales and distribution must be done in the vendor area. Literature and other merchandise may not be sold or distributed in workshops, meetings, plenary sessions, or the Saturday evening banquet.
2. Labor Notes will not be responsible for any lost or stolen merchandise at the conference.
3. Labor Notes reserves the right to refuse any vendors literature table space at our own discretion.
