Logistics


Location

The conference will be at Morgan Hall, 1601 N Broad St, Philadelphia, in room D301 at Temple University. The dorms are adjacent in Morgan North.

Getting to Morgan Hall

By plane: We hope you've booked your ticket! You can use SEPTA (public transit) to get to the conference, but the Caucus of Working Educators is coordinating airport rides.

You can also take regional rail from the airport to the Temple stop at 927 Berks Street. It is a 10 minute to Morgan Hall.



By train: Morgan Hall is reachable by getting off at the Cecil B. Moore stop that's on the Broad Street Line. It's right on the corner as you exit the station.

Parking

There are several pay lots at Temple. Some street parking is available. It should be a little easier as it is summer, but of course, there are some spots with meters and time limits.

Housing

If you are staying in the dorms, you can check in at Morgan Hall North when you arrive (see map).

If you are in a homestay, your host will help coordinate your travel to and from the conference.

Meals
